

Rules of Conduct for Conference Participants

These rules apply to all conference participants. The aim is to ensure that the conference is conducted in a professional manner and in a pleasant environment for all participants. The purpose of these rules is not to restrict freedom of speech, but to protect the rights and freedoms of all participants while respecting the conference's objectives and themes. These rules apply to all conference venues and activities, including:

- conference venues and related locations,
- social events and networking activities,
- online platforms, discussion channels, and social media related to the conference,
- individual communications arising from participation in the conference.

Conference Participation

- All individuals who have registered for the conference are considered conference participants, including accompanying persons, exhibitors, and the organizer's staff,
- Participation in the conference is contingent upon the participant's registration and payment of the registration fee,
- By registering for the conference, you confirm that you have read and understood these rules and agree to abide by them.

Participants

- Participants are required to follow the program and the organizers' instructions,
- Participants must not endanger the safety, health, or dignity of others,
- Any conduct that disrupts the planned course of the program is prohibited, e.g., loud outbursts outside of designated times, whistling, the use of noisy objects (except for objects used by the organizer), entering the stage without permission, placing objects that obstruct the view, etc.,
- Banners, signs, or other items intended for demonstrative purposes are not permitted in the conference venue.

Participants are expected to:

- maintain a professional attitude
- behave respectfully and courteously
- communicate constructively and considerately
- respect differing opinions, perspectives, and experiences
- respect and follow the conference organizers' instructions

Unacceptable Behavior

In all conference-related settings, including lectures, workshops, social events, online platforms, and informal interactions, the following behaviors are considered unacceptable:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination in any form
- offensive, derogatory, or humiliating remarks (written or verbal)
- unwanted sexual attention, advances, or remarks
- intentional disruption of presentations or events
- bullying or repeated inappropriate contact
- any behavior that creates a dangerous or unprofessional environment

Organizer

- The organizer reserves the right to take any measures necessary to ensure a safe and respectful environment,
- in the event of a serious or repeated violation, participation in the conference may be terminated without compensation,
- the organizer has the right to ask a participant to cease inappropriate behavior; if the participant fails to comply, they may be immediately removed from the conference premises,
- the organizer is authorized to request that security personnel remove the disruptor; if necessary, the Czech Police may be called.

Troubleshooting

- If a participant observes behavior that violates these rules, please contact the organizing team,
- the organizers will assess each situation on a case-by-case basis and take appropriate action.
